AMENDMENT OF BY-LAWS OF CHERRY MEADOWS COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC.

The Board of Directors of the Cherry Meadows Community Association, Inc. hereby adopts the following amendments of the By-laws of the Association, which amendments superceded and control any contrary provision in the existing By-Laws.

Article IV, Section 4.1 shall be deleted in its entirety and change to read as follows:

Annual Meetings. The regular annual meeting of Members shall be held on such a date and at such place and time as designated by the Board of Directors in written notice given to all Members at least ten (10) ten days, but no more than thirty (30) days, prior to the date of such meeting for the purpose of electing the Board of Directors of the Association in accordance with Article VII, Section 7.1 herein and for the transaction of other business of the Association as may properly come before the meeting.

Article IV, Section 4.4 shall be deleted in its entirety and changed to read as follows:

Quorum. A quorum of Members for any meeting will be constituted by Members represented in person or by proxy and holding at least 5 percent (5%) of the votes entitled to be cast at such meeting.

Upon motion duly made by Rosemary Cahiil and seconded by Becky Alexander, the following Resolution was unanimously adopted


RESOLVED THAT the Board approved the minutes of the June, 2011 Board meeting as presented.
